

MIC France Wins RATP Contract

Paris, France - Moody International Certification France recently won the tender for a four year contract with RATP (Régie Autonome des Transports Parisiens). In other cities in France, RATP is present either as transports operator, manager, or to provide technical assistance.

- the Territorial Action Department (ISO 9001)
- two Subway Maintenances Workshops (ISO 14001)



Other departments of RATP will be able to apply for the certifications through Moody France, who will certify their compliance to the Quality and Environment Management Systems requirements.
