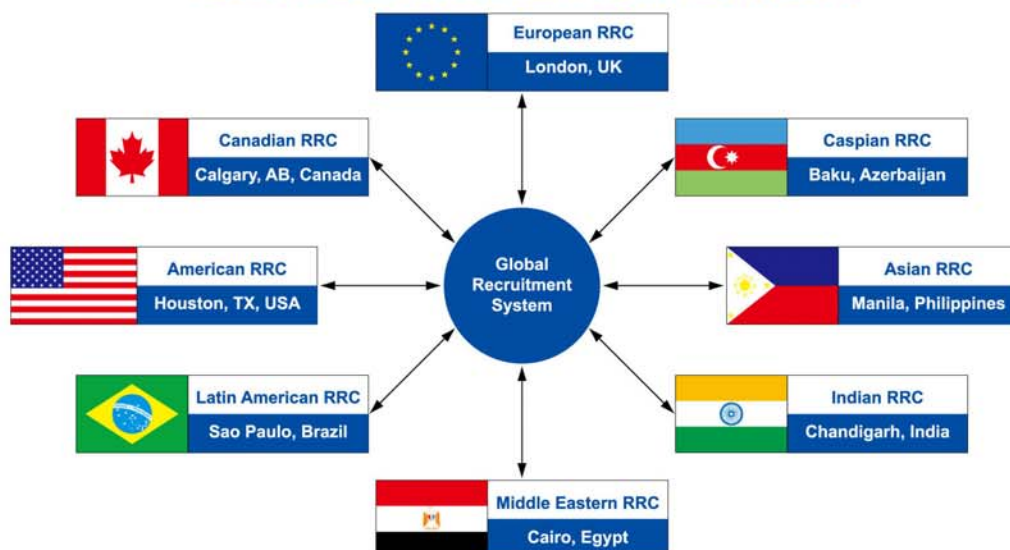

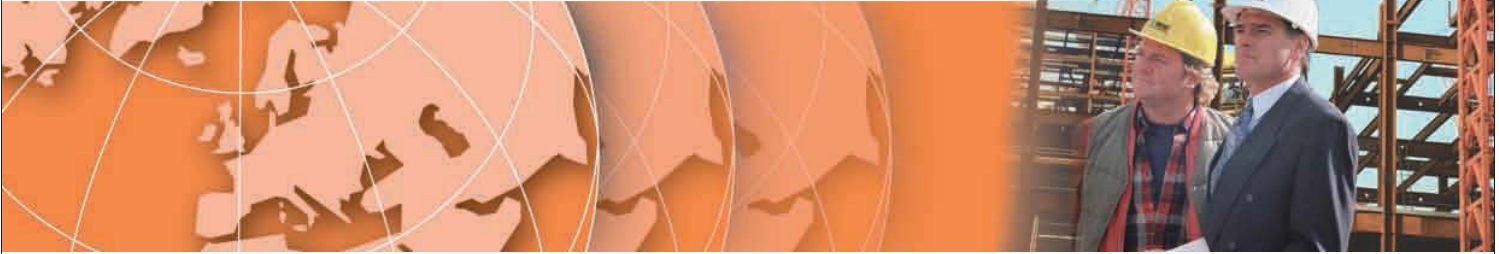

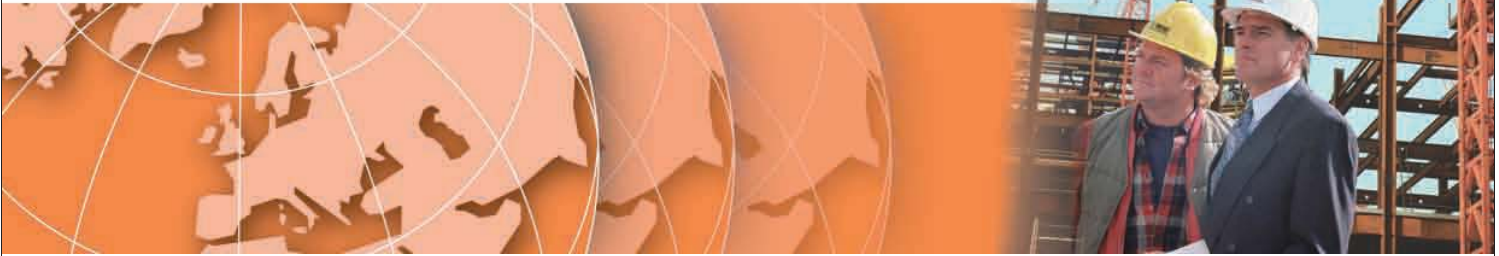

Sakhalin Energy Investment Company Ltd. (SEIC), a consortium of Shell (55%), Mitsui (25%), and Mitsubishi (20%), contracted Moody International to provide Third Party Inspection and Verification Services on the Sakhalin II Development Project. The Sakhalin II Project entails the fabrication, construction and installation of two new platforms (Lunskoye A and Piltun-Asokhskoye B), two parallel pipelines, about 800 km in length, from the offshore platforms in the north via the Onshore Processing Facility (OPF) up to the Liquefied Natural Gas Plant and Oil terminal on the south end of the island, near the city of Korsakov. The project is designed to facilitate the development and transportation of oil and gas for export from the Sakhalin area to international markets.

Moody, in the capacity of Third Party Inspection and Verification Consultant, was responsible for the provision of field construction inspection services. This includes materials compliance verification and receipt inspection, R-O-W preparation, overseeing all welding processes and activities, NDT operations including UT cross-checks, field joint coating operations/coating repairs, cathodic protection and electrical installations, installation of valve & pigging stations, and final examination prior to ditching and backfilling.

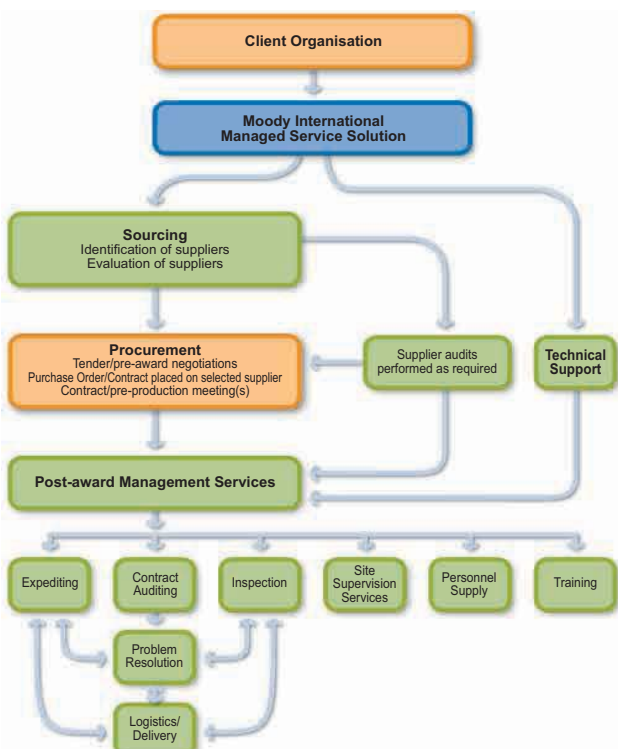

The ISO 9001:2000 standard is one of the most widely known standards, implemented by over 800,000 organisations in 162 countries.

The ISO 9001 standard has become an international reference for quality management requirements in business-to-business relationships.

ISO 9001 helps organisations of any type and size with “quality management” including:

- Fulfilling customers’ quality requirements
- Following applicable regulatory requirements
- Enhancing customer satisfaction
- Achieving continual performance improvement in pursuit of these objectives.

The standard has earned a worldwide reputation known as the “generic quality management system standard”, which can be applied to any organisation, large or small, whatever its business, product or service.

“Management system” refers to the organisation’s structure for managing its processes or business activities. This structure transforms input of resources into a product or service that meets the organisation’s business objectives, satisfies the customer’s quality requirements and complies with regulations.

ISO 9001 provides a framework of requirements for management to address customer focus, process the management approach, and pursue continuous performance improvement.

ISO/TS 16949:2002

Quality Management System For Automotive Suppliers



Beginning in 1994 with the successful launch of QS 9000, DaimlerChrysler, Ford and GM recognised the increased value that could be derived from an independent quality system audit programme, and the efficiencies that could be gained in the supply chain by having common system requirements.

In 1996, the success of these efforts led to a move toward the development of a globally harmonised quality management system requirements document. From this, the International Automotive Task Force (IATF) was formed to lead the development effort.

The IATF is a group of automotive manufacturer and trade associations whose common goal is to improve the quality of products to the automotive industry worldwide. IATF members include the “Big 3”, along with Fiat, Citroen, VW, Renault and national automotive trade associations from the USA, Germany, France, UK, and Italy. The Japanese vehicle association, JAMA, has also been involved with the IATF’s efforts to develop ISO/TS 16949.

The result of the IATF’s effort is the ISO/TS 16949 specification which forms the requirements of ISO 9001 for automotive production and relevant service part organisations.



Of major impact to the automotive supply base are several OEMs announcement of deadline dates for ISO/TS 16949:2002 upgrades. Clearly the future belongs to ISO/TS 16949.

ISO 14001:2004

Environmental Management System



With the worldwide growing concerns regarding our living environment, ISO 14001 is recognised more and more as an organisation's high level commitment to environmental protection.

Over 110,000 organisations in 138 countries have implemented ISO 14001 standard requirements in their environmental management system and have been assessed and certified. This demonstrates commitment to meet environmental challenges.

The ISO 14001 standard is primarily concerned with the approach of "environmental management", which provides guidance to the organisation in order to:

- Minimise harmful effects on the environment caused by business activities; and
- Achieve continual improvement of environmental performance.

The standard is widely recognised as a "generic environmental management system standard" which can be applied to any organisation, large or small, whatever its product or service.



"Management system" refers to the organisation's structure for managing its processes or activities. This structure transforms input of resources into a product or service that meets the organisation's environmental objectives such as complying with regulations and resource effectiveness.

The standard follows the structure of ISO 14001, requiring top-level commitment to compliance with legislation, prevention of accidents, promotion of good health and continual improvement.

HACCP & ISO 22000

Food Safety Management Standard



Hazards Analysis & Critical Control Points Food Safety Management System

HACCP is a widely recognised and used product safety management principle in food manufacturing, processing, treatment and service organisations. Implementation of HACCP is a legislative requirement for the food industry in many countries.



By partnering with a quality management system, the food organisation is able to manage the safety of food products under the internationally recognised management system structure. HACCP principles require identification of the critical control points in the manufacturing or service processes and set up of the controls for food safety.

Moody International has developed a technical specification of requirements for an operational HACCP system accredited by UKAS to be used in audit and certification in the food manufacturing and servicing industries.

ISO 22000:2005 Food Safety Management System

ISO 22000 is an international standard designed to ensure worldwide safe food supply chains and provide a framework of internationally harmonised requirements for the global approach that is needed.

A major resulting benefit is that ISO 22000 makes it easier for organisations to implement the Codex HACCP (Hazards Analysis and Critical Control Points) system for food hygiene in a harmonised way, which does not vary with the country or food product concerned.

ISO 22000 allows all types of organisations within the food supply chain to implement a food safety management system. The supply chain members range from farms, feed producers, primary producers, food manufacturers, transport and storage operators and subcontractors to retail and food service outlets together with related business such as producers of equipment, packaging material, cleaning agents, additives and ingredients.

Food safety management systems that conform to ISO 22000 can be certified. This answers the growing demand in the food sector for the certification of suppliers. The standard can also be implemented solely for the benefits it provides without certification of conformity.

Global Food Standard



BRC-FOOD **The British Retail Consortium**

BRC first issued the Global Food Standard in 1998 with the intention of eliminating multiple audits by retailer and third party auditors on food manufacturers supplying UK retailers with their own brand products.

This standard is used as the benchmark for food safety management and has been extensively revised to reflect EU legislation and continuous best practice requirements.

It possesses a comprehensive scope covering all areas of product safety and legality issues and addresses part of the due diligence required of both the supplier and the retailer.

The BRC standard has now become the internationally recognised mark of excellence. Certification to the standard verifies technical competence and aids suppliers', brand owners' and retailers' fulfilment of legal obligations. It also safeguards the consumer.

The retailers, food producers, importers, caterers, ingredient suppliers and the food service industry can all benefit greatly from this essential standard. It is currently used by suppliers in Europe, Africa, the Middle East, Asia, the Far East, Australasia, North and South America.

Moody International is accredited by UKAS to provide certification to all food suppliers.

Moody's certificates are recognised by BRC (British Retail Consortium), which forms a critical part of food supplier qualification.

IFS-FOOD **International Food Standard**

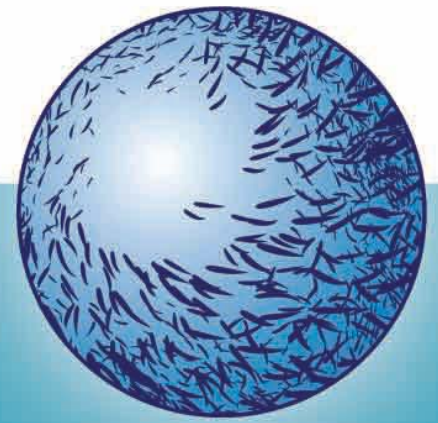
Food retailers (and wholesalers) regularly carry out audits to assess the food safety features of retailer branded food product suppliers. These audits are made by certification body independent auditors.

Every producer of retail branded food products, who is working with German and French retailers (and wholesalers) is affected by IFS audits. Commercial agencies may not need IFS certification, but they can request their suppliers to do so as demonstration that an essential management system is in place.

Moody International is able to provide accredited certification to food suppliers through its strategic partnership in Europe. The certificates are recognised by IFS and form a critical part of supplier qualification.



MOODY MARINE AND FISHERY CERTIFICATION

Fishery certification gives buyers, retailers and general consumers confidence in the origin of fish and fish products, and creates market opportunities for the seafood industry.

The Marine Stewardship Council (MSC) standard, represented by the distinctive blue logo, indicates that fish and fish products have come from well managed and sustainable fisheries. Moody Marine Ltd. is the leading certifier of fisheries against the MSC standard.

Fish production presents many serious challenges for the sustainable use and management of the world's oceans – overfishing and the impact on marine habitats are two examples. This is becoming a major concern to the public and to many within the seafood industry.

Fishery certification is seen as a way of identifying those fisheries which meet high environmental and management standards. This in turn, allows companies that catch, process, or buy the fish to achieve “corporate social responsibility” aims. It also harnesses consumer power to provide market incentives to improve environmental and management standards and performance.

The MSC fishery certification process provides a comprehensive and detailed assessment of a fishery. The detailed nature of the assessment process and extensive consultation with stakeholders means that the process takes approximately 12 months. The following diagram provides a brief description of the steps that are followed:

- A client appoints Moody Marine to undertake a confidential pre-assessment of their fishery.
- The pre-assessment indicates how close the fishery is to meeting the MSC standard and provides appropriate recommendations.



- If the client wishes to proceed, Moody Marine assembles an expert team to assess the fishery against the MSC standard.
- A report is written, peer reviewed and is subject to public consultation and comment.



- Draft reports are peer reviewed and provided for public stakeholder consultation.
- Moody Marine reviews the results of the assessment report, the peer review and public comment and concludes whether the fishery meets the MSC standard.
- The conclusion is posted on the MSC website as a final opportunity for public comment.
- If there is no objection the fishery is certified.
- If there is an objection which cannot be satisfied then the MSC convenes an objections panel and provides a final decision.

Clients for MSC certification may be fishing associations, governments, fish processors/wholesalers or environmental organisations.

MOODY MARINE AND FISHERY CERTIFICATION



Moody Marine has certified large and small scale fisheries around the world. Three examples include:

The South Georgia Patagonian Toothfish Fishery

The fisheries for Patagonian Toothfish (also known as Chilean sea bass) have gained a reputation for illegal fishing and the accidental capture of seabirds such as albatross. Moody Marine's client, the Government of South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands, applied for MSC certification to demonstrate the effectiveness of their management system. Following an exhaustive evaluation, Moody Marine was able to determine that the fishery met the MSC fishery standard. Certification has delivered real market benefits to the fishing companies involved.



The Pacific Albacore Tuna Fishery

The American Albacore Fishing Association is a relatively small, family run fishery operating out of San Diego, California, USA. Using pole/troll and line the Association's 21 vessels catch 3-4,000 tonnes of tuna a year. It is the first tuna fishery to be certified and the Association has reported that since certification there has been increased interest and outlets for their product.

The South African Hake Trawl Fishery

The hake fishery is the largest single component of the South African whitefish trawl fisheries. Following a period of sustained heavy fishing in the latter half of the 20th Century, the hake stock was showing signs of a significant decline. Prompted by this, the South African Government implemented a series of management initiatives to rebuild the stock. Certification provides confirmation of the effectiveness of the management system, points the way to areas of further improvement and provides a basis for the fishery to obtain competitive advantage with environmentally conscious customers.



Moody Marine and Chain of Custody

When a fishery is certified, this is the starting point for downstream MSC "chain of custody" certification for the handling, processing, distribution and eventual consumption by the general public.

MSC chain of custody certification provides assurance of traceability of fish carrying the MSC logo back to the certified fishery.

Moody Marine is an accredited MSC chain of custody certifier with clients in restaurant, retail, processing, wholesale and food service sectors.
